Featured Clinician
AMY KYLER

Amy Kyler, currently in her first year as head coach at Notre Dame College of Ohio, has coached at Purdue University, Cleveland St. and Bowling Green. She’s worked numerous camps and clinics throughout Ohio and the Midwest and is an accomplished pitching coach and clinician.

After a stellar playing career at Cleveland State, Kyler pitched professionally in both the National Pro Fastpitch (NPF) League and the Women’s Professional Softball League (WPSL). She was a member of the Carolina Diamonds (WPSL) in 1997 and 1998, posting a 16-16 record with a 2.42 ERA in 219.1 inning pitched.

In 1999 and 2000, Kyler played for the Akron Racers, helping the team advance to the WPSL Championship semifinal in 1999. She posted a 7-7 record with a 1.97 ERA that season. She was a member of an NPF All-Star touring team in 2003, played for the California Sunbirds in 2004. Most recently Kyler played for the Akron Racers in their 2005 NPF championship season. While in the professional ranks, Kyler was named to WPSL or NPF All-Star team five times (1998-2001, 2003).

Session I - Beginners (\$40)

This session is designed for the player interested in learning the basic mechanics of pitching. The motion will be broken down into basic steps with drills appropriate for sound fundamental development. This session is ideal for beginners and anyone who needs to brush up on the basics of pitching. The change-up will also be introduced.

Session II- Intermediate/Advanced (\$40)

2:00 - 2:30 Registration
2:30 - 4:00 Session II

This session will include a brief overview of basic mechanics followed by an introduction to the change-up, drop ball, rise ball, curve ball and screw ball. Players who select this session should have mastered the basic pitching motion. This session is most appropriate for players who have good command of the fastball and are ready to learn advanced pitches.

EACH SESSION IS LIMITED TO 30 PARTICIPANTS

What to bring: Each pitcher needs to provide their own catcher (no charge). Participants should dress for activity and carry gym shoes into the facility.
