#### Day of Giving -

What an amazing Day of Giving! Thanks to all those who contributed and showed their love for Marietta College on February 14, and a special thanks to the 147 Day of Giving Advocates who helped to spearhead the campaign advocating on behalf of the College. As a result, we reached 100% of our 1,200-donor participation goal (1,203) and achieved a new Day of Giving revenue record (\$283,595).

Additional highlights:

- Donations were received from 43 states and 5 countries (US, Canada, UK, Sweden, and Australia).
- The Board of Trustees released a \$50,000 Trustee Challenge when we reached 1,000 donors and sponsored three Power Hours during which donations were matched with additional gifts. \$5,000 was raised through the Pioneer Peloton Challenge with 30 participants.
- Tiered Project Campaigns:
  - Area of Greatest Need: 564 donors gave \$120,696 (160% of goal)
  - Student Aid: 102 donors gave \$9,295 (37% of goal)
  - Pioneer Club: 29 donors gave \$2,185 (29% of goal)
  - Sport Management: 20 donors gave \$1,328 (13% of goal)
  - Classroom technology: 9 donors gave \$2,804 (40% of goal)
  - Esports Center: 25 donors gave \$1,115 (13% of goal)

- STREAM Camp: 29 donors gave \$4,345 (144% of goal)
- Career Center: 34 donors gave \$7,696 (51% of goal)
- WCMO: 115 donors gave \$20,509 (136% of goal)
- Global Connections: 7 donors gave \$590 (9% of goal)
- Competitions/Challenges In addition to the Class Challenge, we launched the new Sports Challenge, as well as two separate challenges (Fraternities and Sororities) for the Greeks.
  - Class Challenge: Donors spanned 75 years, from classes 1951-2026
    - 1. 1984 18.6% participation
    - 2. 1970 16.3% participation
    - 3. 1985 12.7% participation
  - Greek
    - 1. Chi Omega & Tau Kappa Epsilon both 17.9% participation & (\$500 prize)
    - 2. Alpha Xi Delta 15.8% & Lambda Chi Alpha 15.1% participation
    - 3. Alpha Sigma Tau 5.4% & Delta Tau Delta 5.8% participation
  - Sports Challenge
    - 1. Esports with 23.5% participation
    - 2. Field Hockey with 23.2% participation
    - 3. Men's Soccer

#### Annual Giving Update -

As of February 21, we have raised a total of \$3,208,154 in current-use gifts: \$2,097,469 of which is unrestricted. This puts us at 69.9% of our \$3M Marietta Fund goal and should reach that goal by June 30. Yet, we still need more than 1,100 alumni to contribute before July 1, so that we can meet our 20% participation goal — currently at 12.47% and projections have us ending the year between 15% - 16%.
