

APPLYING FOR ADMISSION TO MARIETTA COLLEGE

The Admission Calendar: You may submit your application to Marietta College between May 1st of your junior year and April 15th of your senior year. We encourage you to file your application as soon as possible, but decisions on admission will not be sent until after we have received final junior year grades. Student who are admitted and plan to enroll must submit a \$200 advanced tuition deposit by May 1st. Deposits made prior to May 1st are refundable. Selection of residence hall and freshman seminar is determined by deposit date – earlier deposits receive priority.

Guidance Counselor Report: Have your guidance or college counselor complete this form and return to Marietta College with a copy of your official high school transcript. If you enroll at Marietta College, your high school transcript will become part of your official file and will be available for your review; your Guidance Counselor Report is confidential, and will not.

ACT and SAT: You are required to submit either ACT or SAT I scores. You may ask to have your test scores sent directly to Marietta College from ACT or the College Board, or they may be reported on your official high school transcript. **Marietta's SAT number is 1444, our ACT number is 3290.**

Teacher Evaluation (optional): If you wish to submit additional recommendations you may have them sent to us directly. If you enroll at Marietta, these recommendations will not become part of your permanent file.

Essay: Marietta College requires that you submit an essay as part of your application. You have four options from which to choose so you can select the one you find most interesting. A typed essay is preferred.

Application Fee: A \$25 application fee must be submitted with your application. Checks and money orders should be made out to Marietta College. If submitting the application fee creates a financial hardship to you and your family, please ask your guidance or college counselor to submit a request for an **application fee waiver** to Marietta on your behalf.

Scholarships: No additional application is necessary to be considered for merit-based scholarships. To ensure full consideration for scholarships please submit your completed application for admission by February 1st
