## FRESHMEN MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS





To be considered for an entering freshmen Merit Scholarship at Marietta College, you must meet all of the following:

- Be fully admitted by the priority date of February 15, 2016 (final transcript must be submitted after high school graduation)
- Meet scholarship eligibility criteria based on the cumulative high school GPA based on a minimum of six semesters work
- Meet scholarship eligibility criteria based on the results of the ACT composite/SAT (Critical Reading and Math) test taken within the past five years and no later than the December 2015 test date
- Have any required remedial work completed by the start of the Fall 2016 semester

Full-time enrollment in a first bachelor's degree program is required for all scholarships.
