

# How to Configure your Computer for the Marietta College Dial-UP MacOS X

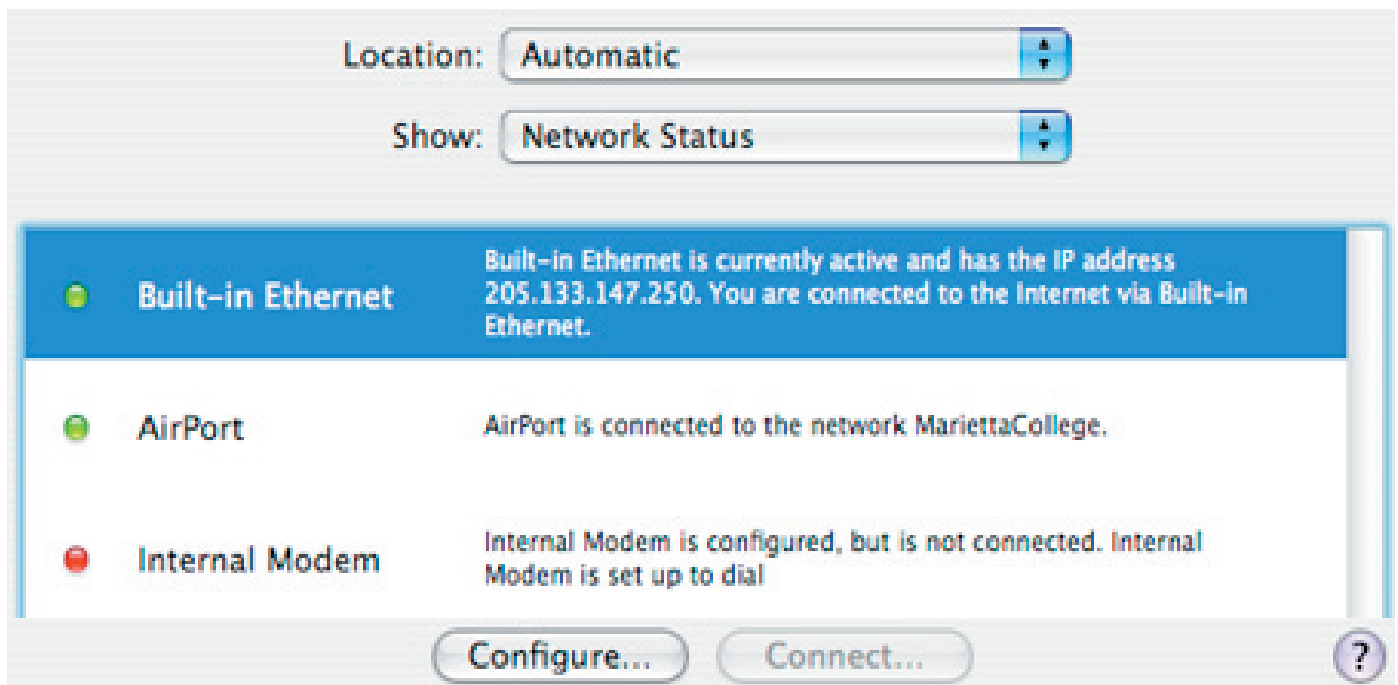
The first thing to do is make sure that you have all the appropriate hardware installed. In most cases any Macintosh made in the past 6 year will have a modem, but some older models and some newer models are no longer shipping with modems. Once a modem has been found and connected to a phone line the computer is ready to be configured.



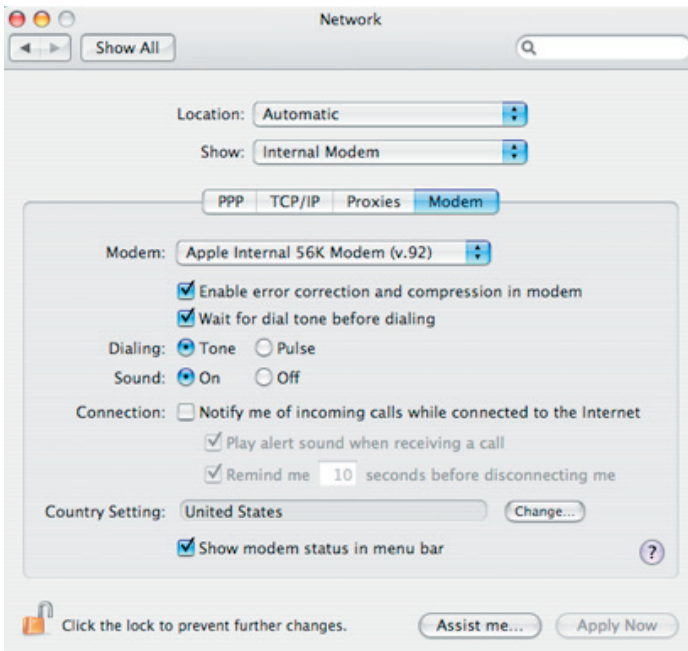
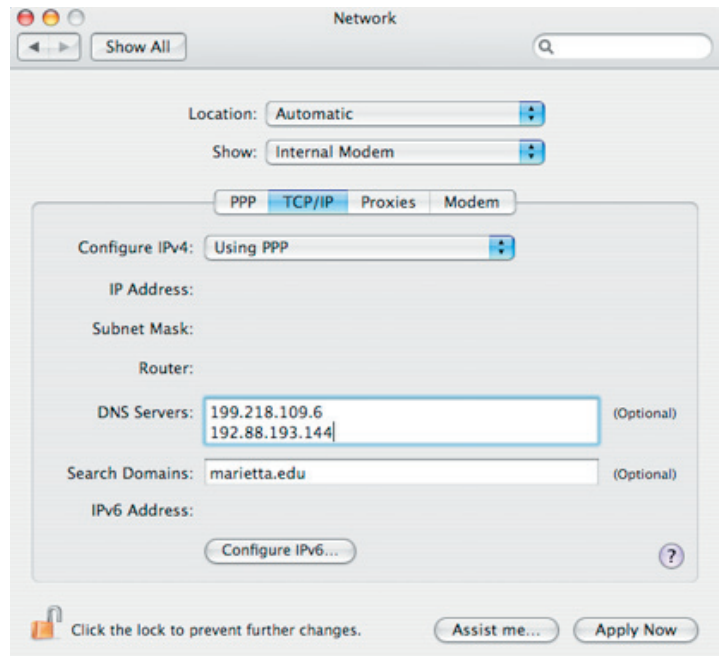
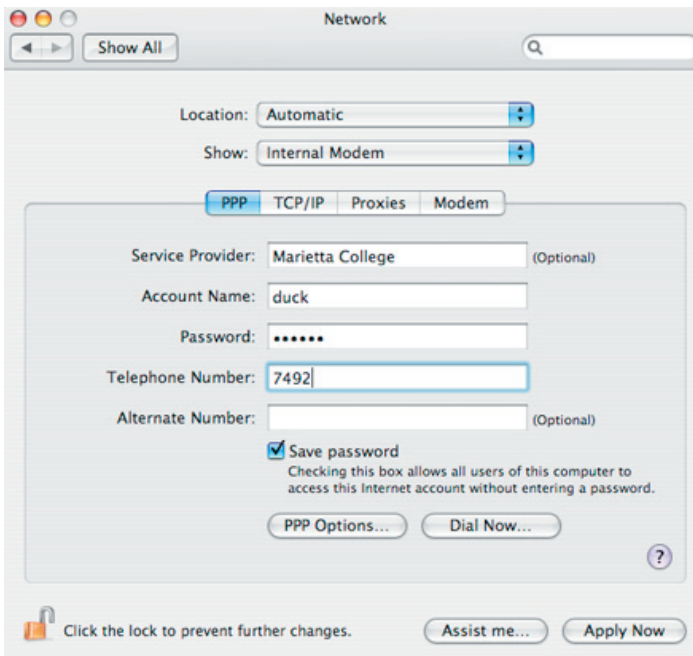
The first step is to open the System Preferences, this is located on your dock or is available from the Apple Menu in the upper left corner of your screen. Once you have opened the System Preferences click on network, this will open the configurations for all of the available network devices installed in the computer



Once Network is open a screen similar to that below should appear, if not, select the drop down Box Labeled Show, and select Network Status to show all available hardware, this will also confirm the presence of a modem in the computer. Select Internal Modem and click configure.

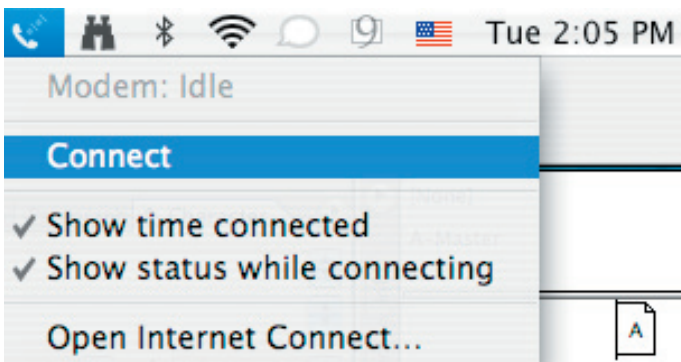


Once your modem configuration is open simply fill in the information as follows in these images, to switch between them click on the PPP and the TCP/IP Tab. The only exception being the phone number, if you are off campus use 376-7492



The final step is to click on the modem tab and select the very last check box to Show modem status in menu bar, this will place a modem icon just to the left of the clock in the upper right corner. Once this is selected click Apply Now to save the settings, then close the window.

Once the settings are saved, there will be a phone icon in the upper right corner, simply click on it and choose connect, the computer should Dial-up to the College and Connect.
