

Annual Juried Student Exhibition Requirements:

The Marietta College Art Department's annual juried student exhibition is open to any student who participates in a Marietta College Art/ARTH/GRPH class during the collecting timeline. The exhibition opens in early spring, February, and runs for one month. Eligible work must come from a MC Art or design class from the previous March to the last day of entry submission collection, a week or ten-days before the opening. For example: the opening is February 21, 2009. We collect entries from February 9 -14, 2009. Any work created/finished from March 2008 to February 14, 2009 is eligible for submission.

If you recently transferred to Marietta College only work done in an MC class can be entered. If you work on personal projects outside of class, that work is ineligible for submission. If you have a major project or series that was started at the beginning of a spring semester, but not completed/ revised until the end of the semester that work is eligible.

Students are allowed to submit up to six items for consideration for the exhibition. All faculty meet to select the best examples for the exhibition and an independent juror selects the prize winners. In the past we exhibited 50 to 70% of the submissions. Just being selected for the exhibition is an honor.
