Casey Trail '05 and Dr. Mark Miller, an associate professor of mathematics had their article, "Sparse Domination of (t,k)-Prisms", published in the most recent edition of *Bulletin of the Institute of Combinatorics and its Applications*. The journal is sent to researchers across the globe in more than 40 countries.
