

## Pledgeship Requirements

1. Each Pledge must spend at least one hour a day with an active while in the house, for 2 of the 5 weekdays. The active does not have to live in the house, but the time spent with the active must be in the shelter. There will be a sign in and out sheet laying on my desk, get it and put your name, time-in, time-out, and have the active initial. Activities acceptable can vary from studying together, or just hanging out playing video games and talking, however IF ALCOHOL IS CONSUMED, THE TIME SPENT **DOES NOT COUNT**. Since this is only 2 required hours per week, and can be fulfilled at any time of the day, failure to complete these hours more than one week will result in me bringing the pledge up for de-pledging to the chapter. Also Pledges must set up a time with me that is compatible with both of our schedules, for a weekly one-on-one meeting, in order for me to better get to know you, and vice versa, as well as me make sure your year is going well. The meetings are not intended to be necessarily long, but can be as long as the pledges would like without conflicting with any scheduling.
2. Quizzes of 5 questions will be given weekly at pledge education meetings on the assigned readings for that week. The pledge must receive an average of 60% (3/5) on the 7 quizzes. Failure to earn a 60% average on pledge quizzes at the end of the 8 week pledging period will result in me bringing the pledge up for de-pledging to the chapter.
3. Since you are a pledge and this is pledge education, your attendance in Pledge Class meetings is essential to your growth as a member of Delta Tau Delta, as well as your transition into an active member of the chapter, your attendance is mandatory. Of course exceptions can and will be made, however excuses **MUST** be emailed to me by the time the chapter meets at 7 on Sundays. Failure to appear and send an email for more than 2 of the 8 weeks will result in me bringing the pledge up for de-pledging.
4. Since you now part of the chapter, your involvement in mandatory chapter activities is required as well. The attendance policy will be reviewed with you, and you are expected to follow it accordingly, and will be subjugate to any penalties outlined in the policy, just as actives are. The same goes for the Chapters Academic and financial policies.

I understand and accept the above expectations to become a member in Epsilon Upsilon Chapter of Delta Tau Delta, and also understand that not accomplishing these requirements could result in the chapter deciding to deny your initiation
