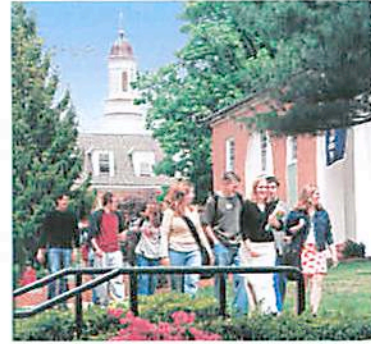


Summer Honors Institute Institute Rules

The following rules are in effect during the Summer Honors Institute to guarantee that you have a safe and rewarding week.



1. All participants must be with a staff member at all times when outside of the residence hall.
2. Permission to leave the group for any reason must be obtained from the staff member in charge.
3. Lights out in the residence hall is 12:00 a.m.
4. Participants should be friendly and respectful to all Institute participants and to all faculty and staff.
5. Respect for students and adults in other summer programs should be observed while on campus including in the academic buildings, dining hall, and residence hall.
6. Teaching Assistants and Residence Assistants along with the Institute faculty and staff have the authority to enforce all Institute and campus rules and to settle any disputes.
7. All medications must be kept with Carma Schilling, the Institute nurse.
8. Guidelines for classes and labs:
 - a. No gum, food, or drinks
 - b. One person speaks at a time
 - c. All safety rules regarding use of laboratories and equipment must be followed at all times
 - d. All participants are to be respectful of the instructors and assistants.
9. Guidelines for Gilman Dining Hall
 - a. Take what you want but eat what you take!
 - b. Sit at the tables designated for the Summer Honors Institute
 - c. No running or horseplay
 - d. All trays and dishes need to be returned to the window.
 - e. No food or drinks may be removed from the dining hall.
 - f. Make sure your eating area is clean before leaving
10. Failure to abide by these rules or those listed in the Welcome Handbook may result in early dismissal from the program.
