# Appeal for Special Circumstance Policy



### **Appeal Policy**

Your eligibility for financial aid was initially calculated based on the information you provided on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Using this information all families undergo a consistent evaluation of the family's ability to pay for college. The formula assumes that 2020 income is a good indicator of the family's financial strength during the student's 2023-2024 enrollment.

Student Financial Services at Marietta College recognizes that families experience changes in income or other family circumstances that are not reflected in the 2021 tax return information. Therefore, it is possible for students to appeal their financial aid eligibility if they have special financial circumstances.

#### **Examples of Special Circumstances considered:**

- Reduction of income or benefits in 2023.
- Extraordinary medical or dental expenses in 2021.
- Death of a parent or spouse whose information is on the FAFSA form.
- Divorce or separation after filing the 2023-2024 FAFSA form.
- Natural Disaster expenses not covered by Insurance

#### **Examples of Special Circumstances not considered:**

- Home repairs
- Private school tuition
- Credit card debt
- Mortgage payments
- Weddings and other major purchases
- Car payments
- Previous educational loan debt

Please remember, granting appeals is based on a one-time special circumstance. It also depends on the availability of funds and the timeliness of your FAFSA. Submitting this form does not guarantee an adjustment or increase in your financial aid. In the event that we are not able to offer additional financial aid please review the alternative financing options and payment plans available to help finance your education. Appeals are reviewed within 30 days after receipt of all required and supporting documentation. However, response times may vary depending on volume of appeals at the time of your request.
