COMMON REASONS STUDENTS SEEK SERVICES

- Acute visits for upper-respiratory illness, minor injuries, sore throat, wound care
- Testing for Mono, strep, pregnancy, flu, glucose, urinalysis, STIs, COVID
- Medical management of anxiety and depression
- Allergy shots/Depo-Provera injections
- Routine Physicals
- OTC medications and some prescriptions available with office visit
- GYN issues
- Discuss medication refills with correct medical documents provided
- Placement and Removal of sutures/staples
- If higher level of care is needed a referral will be placed to local specialist
