- Cap & gown orders must be submitted to [Herff Jones](#) by March 15 for pick up at GradFest (see below);
- Mandatory Grad Fest: Enrolled May, August, and December 2026 graduates must participate in this mandatory event to confirm various details related to graduation; Look for an email with location, date, and times in early March.
- The Long Blue Line Brunch: This traditional event will be held May 9. Advance registration is required at <https://www.marietta.edu/2026-long-blue-line-brunch> by April 30.

Other documents include information on the Jewett Competition, Exit Loan Counseling, and an informational letter from Bruce Heflin Photography, who will be taking photos during the ceremony. Be sure to scan the QR code in his letter to upload a selfie and to register friends and family with whom you wish to share photos of the day's festivities!
