Annual Giving Update

Year-to-date alumni participation is below what it was at the same time last year (currently at 3.67% - 547 as opposed to 5.21% - 772 at the same time last year). The importance of peer-to-peer follow-up by the MCAAC will be key as we focus on promoting current fundraising projects, including the Day of Giving. We need an additional 2,221 alumni donors to reach our goal of 20% alumni participation.

- Donors continue the national trend of restricting their support to programs or projects that are most meaningful to them. (Three times more restricted donors than unrestricted.
- As of October 31, we have raised a total of \$922,069 in current use gifts; \$378,798 of which is unrestricted. Currently, we are at 12.63% of our \$3M Marietta Fund goal.



Ongoing Strategies

 Ongoing fundraising strategies include the Fall Appeal, Giving Tuesday, Calendar Year-End Appeal, Special Campaigns, Title IX, Center for Digital Engagement, Personal Solicitations, and the Day of Giving.

Day of Giving

The Day of Giving will be held from 12:00 am - 11:59pm (Eastern), February 14. The participation goal will be 1,200 donors.

- The committee is identifying advocates with a focus on the various campaigns, including the Greek Challenge, Class Year/ Decade, and new this year, the Sports Challenge.
- Identifying prospects and alumni champions for Tiered Campaigns, which to date include:
 - Area of Greatest Need, Student Aid, Pioneer Club (athletics), Experiential Education (Career Center), WCMO, DEI Initiative, and Classroom technology/upgrades.
- Identifying Engagement Events including performances, Trivia Night.
