Marietta College has announced a new strategic plan — *Marietta Forward* — that will guide the College into the future, according to President Dr. Margaret L. Drugovich. The plan was approved by the Board of Trustees after an extensive strategic planning process.

Marietta Forward focuses on supporting Marietta students, strengthening current academic programs, developing new programs for graduate and non-

2024-25 FAFSA® open for filing

The 2024-25 FAFSA® is open for filing, and we encourage you to file so that your eligibility for federal student aid and state aid can be established. File the <u>FAFSA® online</u> for the quickest filing.

However, because of ongoing issues, the US Department of Education does not expect to start sending FAFSA® data to schools until mid-March. We cannot assess eligibility for federal student aid until such data is received and has been reviewed and, if necessary, verification is performed. Further, states cannot assess eligibility for their state grant programs until they receive such data as well.

We encourage you to access programming content on filing the FAFSA® from various resources. A list of such is <u>available on Marietta College's website</u>.
