



What is WITS?

WITS stands for Women in the Sciences, an award winning program of hands-on science, math, career, and computer application activities during a week long summer camp.

When is WITS? June 22-28, 2014

Who is Eligible?

Students currently in grades 7 through 11 may apply. Selection is based upon teacher recommendations, essays, and the date the application is received. **Enrollment will be limited to 50 students.**

Cost

Commuter: \$100 (includes all daily activities plus lunch)
Residential: \$200 (includes room, board, meals, daily activities, and evening recreational activities)

Residential Camp

Students will stay in Marietta Hall, an air-conditioned college residence, under the supervision of trained college counselors and adult staff members. Meals, several activities such as Gilman Student Center, are planned to accommodate a variety of dietary needs.



Commuter Camp

Students who choose to commute will arrive each day at 8:15 a.m. for camp activities and depart at 5:00 p.m. Commuting students may participate in evening recreational activities for an additional charge.

Camp Sessions

The 2014 camp will consistently include hands-on activities:

- Field Trip
- Geology
- Psychology
- Computers
- Animal Behavior
- Chemistry
- Mathematics
