Marietta College makes academic guidance and counseling an integral part of the education method. The instructor for the First-Year Experience course is the student's academic advisor for at least the first two semesters. Generally, by the beginning of the third semester the student should make arrangements through the Records Office to select a department advisor in a major area of study. Transfer students are assigned an advisor in their major department during the admissions process. It is the student's responsibility to seek out his or her advisor for help, and each student is responsible for learning the requirements, policies, and procedures governing the academic program he or she is following.
