If a conflict prevents you from participating in this required one-stop shop, or if you will be participating in Commencement but not currently enrolled, please contact the Records Office at records@marietta.edu to make other arrangements. You will need to provide verification that you participated to pick up your cap and gown from the bookstore.
- **<u>Diploma distribution</u>**: Grades will be processed on May 11 so diplomas will not be distributed at Commencement. Spring graduates will be notified by email when diplomas are available.

Other enclosures include information on the Jewett Competition, the 2017 Commencement Schedule and Senior Send Off schedule of events, and a letter from Bruce Heflin Photography, who will take cap and gown portraits as well as a photograph of you shaking hands with President Ruud.
